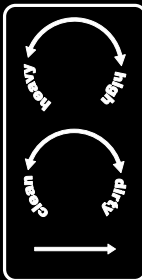


## GERMANIUM FILTER

The *GERMANIUM FILTER* is our love letter to sticking a pencil through your speaker. Start with a console-style drive circuit, made from obsolete germanium transistors, and finish it off with a super intense DBA-style filter, and BLAMO! You've got a sound heavy enough to crush and sharp enough to slice.

The Filter control is extremely versatile - it'll take you from bottomless, sub-woofered out lows to super searing and brittle highs, with a universe of tone in between.

The Gain control starts with a dirty boost that then spans through saturated drive, spitting distortion, and a blistering fuzz tone. Get ready for your sound to be Germaniumized!



**heavy - high:** This is the filter knob. Heavy is a deep bass booster and high is a treble screamer. Turning the knob sweeps through a wide range of cut and boosted frequencies.

**clean - dirty:** This is the gain knob. It ranges from a dirty boost (clean) to a blistering fuzz (dirty).

**NOTE:** Even with the gain knob turned to 'clean' the sound of the Germanium Filter is always overdriven.



### INTERNAL CONTROL:

Sets the overall output volume of the pedal. Ranges from no sound to maximum volume.

**NOTE:** To access this control, unscrew the 4 screws on the back of the pedal.



**POWER:** Operates on a standard 9V DC power supply (2.1mm, center-negative). We recommend Death By Audio's **RAW POWER** power supply for optimal performance. The pedal draws 5 mA of current when engaged.
